Integrated Team Care (ITC) Program

The program is for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people with chronic disease living in the Great Southern and Southern Wheatbelt regions. The program supports the full pathway of care, from encouragement and assistance to accessing health care through to provision of multidisciplinary care.



Eligibility Criteria

- patients must identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- be enrolled for chronic disease management in a general practice
- patients with diabetes, cancer, cardiovascular disease, chronic respiratory disease and chronic kidney disease



Referral Requirements

- Referrers must forward a GP Management Plan & completed ITC GP referral form for the patient



Prioritising Patients

Care coordination will be prioritized for clients with complex care needs and multiple supplementary service providers



Items Funded Include:

- Webster packs (but no medications)
- CPAP machines & accessories
- Spacers & nebulizers
- Blood glucose machines
- Medical footwear prescribed by a podiatrist
- Mobility aids (crutches, walking frames, non-electrical wheelchairs & shower chairs)
- Glasses (conditions apply - check with Coordinator)
- Bed hires for palliative care
- Transport support (if PATS not available)
- All medical appointments - specialists (available locally first)
- Allied health consults
- Exceptional circumstances



Items Not Funded Include:

- Dental services
- Electric wheelchairs & gophers
- Procedures & operations
- Appointments that were attended before the patient joined the program
